Talk to yourself to find out your strengths and weaknesses by Anil Jathar under Sat@BV

These were the words of guidance by Mr. Anil Jathar, X-ray consultant BPL, Bangalore addressing students of engineering at Sat@BV, on 05th Aug, 2017, Bharati Vidyapeeth University College of Engineering Pune. Sat@BV is the programme arranged for students to have a direct interaction with industry people. This activity makes students understand expectations of industry from them as budding engineers. This activity is a step forward by the Principal, Dr. AnandBhalerao for bridging the gap between Industry and Academics. This activity started three years back and got a good response from students as well eminent industry personalities. The speaker elaborated on management policies comparing Indian and Western one. While an American manager will assign a task to someone who will be having respective expertise and get the task done in minimal time, and Indian manager will assign it randomly and then the delay will be blamed on the respective person. He also added that the Indian engineers are bright but lack in hard work. There is lot of need to improve in their documentation, too. Integrity is crucial for success of a person. It is important that every person should introspect whether the act is as per integrity policy or not. The Principal Dr. AnandBhalerao felicitated and introduced the speaker. In his brief speech he shared small story of world war II. Every individual tries to give others what he has. After world war II Germany was divided into East Germany and West Germany. East Germany people threw garbage and waste at the border of West Germany. In response to this action, West Germany put packed food, medicines, clothes on the border.
